Orrin Cooper, a 10 year-old boy, died Friday at the County Home, after a week's sickness with pneumonia. Funeral services were held Sunday aftereoon from the home, Rev. J. A. Wood officiating, and the remains buried in Springdale cemetery. The boy, with his brother, was committed to the home five years ago from Farmington. His father and two sisters, who live at Plainville, were present at the funeral. The death rate at 'the County Home has been very low, this being only the fourth to occur since Superintendent Adams took charge, four years ago. With the exception of a few colds, there is no sickness at the home at present.
