Joseph Jordan, Abandoned Boy.

Judge Edward J. Garvan in chambers yesterday afternoon, committed Joseph Jordan, 4 years old, to the Hartford County Temporary Home, as an abandoned child. The boy was born out of wedlock. His mother, Mary Dolan lives in this city but it was said yesterday the whereabouts of the father from whom the boy takes his name are unknown. The boy has been at the almshouse about three and one-half years.

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
